CYGNET PURE BABY PRINTS
NEWBORN BABY OVERALLS

Materials

4 mm crochet hook

1 100g ball of Cygnet Pure Baby Prints DK in Pink Blossom 1883

Small amount of Cygnet Pure Baby DK in Lilac 2113

4 stitch markers or scrap yarn

2 x 15mm wooden buttons

Pattern Notes –

UK terminology used

The number in Brackets, is the amount of stitches or pattern repeats you should have at the end of that row.

The chain 1 does not count as a stitch, always work into the 1st stitch of the row unless otherwise stated.

Cluster stitch – work a double crochet and a treble crochet into the same stitch or space.

Abbreviations –

htr – half treble crochet
tr – treble crochet
dc – double crochet
cl – cluster

ch(s) - chain(s)
chsp- chain space
t - turn your work
nxt – next
rept - repeat

sk - skip
sp(s) - space(s)
slst – slip stitch
fo – fasten of

Legs – make 2

Loosely ch 30, slst to form into a ring

Row 1 – ch 1, * cl into 1st ch, sk 1, rept from * around, slst to 1st st (15)

Rows 2 to 12 – ch 1, t, * cl into dc, rept from * around, slst to 1st st

After completing the 2nd leg, do not fasten off

Joining legs –

Rept row 12 one more time, do not slst to join, continue working the 15 cl on the 2nd leg, slst to the 1st dc on the 1st leg to join.

Rows 14 to 27 - ch 1, t, * cl into dc, rept from * around, slst to 1st st (30)

Fasten off

Lay piece flat and using st markers, section off the 8 central clusters on the front and back

Bib section –**Front –**

Attach yarn into the 1st sc of the sectioned off area

Row 1 – ch 1, * cl into 1st dc, rept from * 7 more times, dc into last dc (8)

Rows 2 to 8 – rept row 1

Back –

Rept rows 1 to 8 for front, do not fasten off

Straps –

Row 1 – ch 1, t, * cl into dc, rept from * 1 more time, dc into last dc, (2)

Rows 2 to 16 – rept row 1

Trim –

Attach your contrasting colour into any stitch on the back.

Ch 1 and work 1 htr into each stitch all the way around, working 3 x htr into the outer corners to move around. Slst to the 1st htr, fo

Attach yarn on the ankle and work 1 htr into each st around, slst to 1st st., rept for other leg.

Fasten off and weave in all ends and sew buttons onto the straps

The space between the 1st and 2nd clusters will become your buttonholes.



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
