

CY1251 BOHO SPIRIT SHORT SHAWL

You Will need -

2 x 100g Balls Cygnet Boho Spirit in Flame 6388

5.50 mm Crochet Hook

Darning Needle

Piece of Cardboard to make tassels

Pattern Notes

UK Terminology used

The CH 1 does not count as a stitch. Always work into the 1st Stitch of the Row unless otherwise stated

Chain 5 at the beginning of the row, counts as 1 Double Treble crochet and 1 chain

This pattern is an easy 1 row repeat

The size of the shawl can be made longer or shorter by making more or fewer rows.

Abbreviations -

TC - Treble Crochet DTC – Double Treble crochet CH - Chain SK – Skip SS - Slip Stitch REP - Repeat ST - stitch REM - Remaining T - Turn your work NXT - Next SP - Space

Row 1 - CH 5 and SS to Join into a ring / CH 5 (counts as double treble and CH 1) and Into the Ring work 3 x TC / CH 2 / 3 TC / CH 1 / DTC

Row 2 - CH 5 / T / work 3 X TC into the DTR space from the row before / CH 1 and into the CH 2 SP (the peak) work 3 X TC + CH 2 + 3 X TC / CH 1 / work 3 X TC into the DTR space from the row before/ CH 1 / and in the 4th CH work a DTR

Row 3 - CH 5 / T / work 3 X TC into the TR space from the row before / CH 1 / into the CH 1 SP work 3 X TC / CH 1 / into the CH 2 SP at the peak work / 3 X TC + CH 2 + 3 X TC / CH 1 / into the CH 1 SP work 3 X TC / CH 1 / work 3 X TC into the TR space from the row before / CH 1 / and in the 4th CH work a DTR

Continue to work as before -

- CH 5 and Turn
- 3 X TC in the DTC SP
- CH 1 to move across and place 3 x TC in every CH 1 SP
- CH 1 and Work your peak by adding 3 x TC + CH 2 + 3 x TC into the CH 2 SP from the row before
- Work down the other side with a CH 1 to move across and place 3 x TC in every CH 1 SP
- To Finish CH 1, and work 3 x TC in the DTC space, and work a DTC into the 3rd CH

Row 4 you will have 2 CH 1 Spaces to work into on each side

Row 5 you will have 3 CH 1 spaces to work into on each side

Row 6 you will have 4 CH 1 spaces to work into on each side......and so on.

Keep repeating the Row until your Shawl if your desired Length, remembering to leave enough yarn if you wish to make Tassels

To Make tassels - The Height of your card will determine the length of your tassel

- Cut a piece of Cardboard to which ever height you prefer
- Cut 6 Lengths of yarn
- Wrap your yarn around the Cardboard 15 times
- Slip one piece of yarn though the center and tie tightly at the top
- Slide the Tassel off the cardboard and lay flat on top of a piece of yarn that is laying horizontal
- Tie tightly around about 2 cm from the top
- Use a darning needle to feed these lengths though the center to blend them in
- Use the 1st 2 lengths to attach to the shawl in all 3 Corners
- Use a darning needle to feed these lengths though the center to blend them in
- Trim Neatly



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
