



**CABLE AND RIBBON SWEATER**

**SPRINKLES POP CHUNKY**  
**CY1960**

## MEASUREMENTS

Actual Chest Size 57 – 64 – 67 cm [22 ½ - 25 ¼ - 26 ½ ] in

## MATERIALS

Cygnet Sprinkles Pop Chunky 3[3-4] 100g balls shade Lavender Honey 641

A pair of 5 and 6 mm (US 8 and 10) Knitting needles

Stitch holders. Cable needle.

## TENSION

15 sts and 20 rows to 10 cm (4 ins) measured over stocking stitch using 6 mm needles

**If your tension is too tight use a larger needle, if too loose use a smaller needle**

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Stst Stocking Stitch** One row K, one row P.

**C2L** Place next 2 sts to a cable needle and hold at front of work, P2 then K2 from cable needle.

**C2R** Place next 2 sts to a cable needle and hold at back of work, K2 then K2 from cable needle.

**C4F** Place next 2 sts to a cable needle and hold at front of work, K2 then K2 from cable needle.

**C4B** Place next 2 sts to a cable needle and hold at back of work, K2 then K2 from cable needle.

## SWEATER

### BACK

Using 5 mm needles cast on 48[52,56] sts and K2 rows.

Work 8 rows in 2 x 2 rib.

Change to 6 mm needles and cont in stst until work measures

18[22,24] cm ending with a P row.

### Shape Raglan

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 42[46,50] sts.

**Next row** K1 K2tbl, K to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

**Next row** Purl.

Rept last 2 rows until 38[40,40] sts rem ending with a P row.

### Divide For Back

#### Opening

**Next row** K1 K2tbl, K16[17,17], turn and work on these sts only.

**Next row** K2, P to end.

\* Keeping 2 sts at opening edge K every row, cont dec every alt row at raglan edge as set until 7[8,10]sts rem.

### Back Neckband

Keeping 3 knit sts at opening edge work rem sts in 2 x 2 rib for 6 rows.

Cast off in patt.

With rs facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts and complete from \*

### FRONT

Stitch markers can be used for guidance as to where the centre panel starts and ends.

Move the markers up as additional rows are worked.

Using 5 mm needles cast on 56[60,64] sts and K2 rows.

**1<sup>st</sup> row** [K2, P2]4[4,5] times, K2, P0[2,0] pm, P2, K2, P4, C4F, P4, K2, P2, pm, P0[2,0], K2 then [P2, K2] 4[4,5] times.

**2<sup>nd</sup> row** [P2, K2] 4[4,5] times, P2, K0[2,0], K2, P2, K4, P4, K4, P2, K2, K0[2,0], P2, then [K2, P2] 4[4,5] times.

Keeping 18[20,22] sts each side in 2 x 2 rib as set, cont in patt on centre 20 sts as follows:

**3<sup>rd</sup> row** P2, [C2L, C2R] twice, P2.

**4<sup>th</sup> row** K4 [P4, K4] twice.

**5<sup>th</sup> row** P4, C4B, P4, C4F, P4.

**6<sup>th</sup> row** as 4<sup>th</sup> row

**7<sup>th</sup> row** P2, C2R, C2L, C2R, C2L, P2.

**8<sup>th</sup> row** K2, P2, K4, P4, K4, P2, K2.

Change to 6 mm needles and now work the 18[20,22] sts each side in stst cont working patt panel as follows:

**9<sup>th</sup> row** P2, K2, P4, C4F, P4, K2, P2.

**10<sup>th</sup> row** As 8<sup>th</sup> row

**11<sup>th</sup> row** As 3<sup>rd</sup> row.

**12<sup>th</sup> row** as 4<sup>th</sup> row.

**13<sup>th</sup> row** P4, C4F, P4, C4B, P4.

**14<sup>th</sup> row** As 4<sup>th</sup> row.

**15<sup>th</sup> row** As 7<sup>th</sup> row.

**16<sup>th</sup> row** As 8<sup>th</sup> row.

These 16 rows form the patt for centre panel.

Cont until Front

measures same as Back to Raglan Shaping ending with a ws row.

### Shape Raglan

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 50[54,58] sts

**Next row** K1 K2togtbl, patt to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

**Next row** Patt to end.

Rept last 2 rows until 36[38,42] sts rem ending with a P row.

### Shape Neck

**Next row** K1, K2togtbl, patt 10[10,12], turn and work on these sts only.

\* Still dec every alt row at raglan edge, dec one st

at neck edge in every row to 5[5,4] sts

Dec at raglan edge only until 2 sts rem. P2togtbl and fasten off.

With rs facing, slip centre 10[12,12] sts to a holder, rejoin yarn and work as given from \* until 2 sts rem. P2tog and fasten off.

### SLEEVES

Using 5 mm needles cast on 24[26,28] sts and K2 rows.

Work 8 rows in 2 x 2 rib. Change to 6 mm needles and work in stst, inc one st at each end of every 4<sup>th</sup>[5<sup>th</sup>,5<sup>th</sup>] row to 40[42,42] sts.

Cont without further shaping until Sleeve measures 23[27,29] cm or length required from beg, ending with a ws row.

### Shape Top

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 34[36,36] sts.

**Next row** K1 K2togtbl, K to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

**Next row** Purl.

Rept last 2 rows until 6 sts rem ending with a P row.

Leave sts on a holder.

### FRONT NECKBAND

Join front raglan seams. With rs facing, and using 5 mm needles, K across sts on first sleeve holder,

pick up and K9 sts down left front neck, K across sts on holder at centre front, pick up and K9 sts up right front neck and K across sts on 2<sup>nd</sup> sleeve holder. 40[42,42] sts.

Work 6 rows in 2 x 2 rib.  
Cast off in rib.

**MAKING UP**  
Join side and sleeve seams.  
Sew on 2 pieces of contrasting ribbon either

side at back neck opening and tie in a bow.  
Alternatively make a button loop at neckband edge and sew on a decorative button on opposite side
