MEASUREMENTS

Actual Measurement: 102[112: 122] cm 40[44:48] in

MATERIALS

4[4,5,] 100g balls of Cygnet 100% Cotton DK in shade 6724 Peach Sorbet

The quantities of yarn stated are based upon average requirements and are therefore approximate.

A pair of 3.25 mm (UK10) and 4 mm (UK 8) knitting needles

Stitch holders

Tension:

22 sts and 28 rows to 10 cm, 4 in, measured over stocking stitch using 4 mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

VERY IMPORTANT: IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE SUCCESS.

If there are less stitches and rows to 10cm, 4in, than the number stated, change to a finer needle, if there are more stitches and rows than stated change to a larger needle.

NOTES: Instructions are given for 102 cm, 40 in, larger sizes are given in brackets.

Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes.

Where the figure 0 appears, no sts, rows or times are worked for this size.

Owing to photography and printing restrictions, the colour reproduction is matched as closely as possible to the yarn

BACK

Using 3.25 mm needles cast on 112[122,134] sts and k6 rows. Change to 4 mm needles and work in stst until back measures 60.5[63,65] cm ending with a ws row.

Shape Shoulders

Cast off 5[5,6] sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Shape back neck

Next row (rs) Cast off 5[6,6], K until there are 26[30,34] sts on right hand needle, turn. Leaving rem sts on a holder.

Dec one st at neck edge in next 6 rows and **at same time** cast off 5[6,7] sts at beg of 2nd and foll 2 alt rows.

Work one row then cast off rem sts.

With rs facing, slip centre 40[40,42] sts to a holder, rejoin yarn and K to end.

Complete to match first side of neck, reversing shapings.

FRONT

Work as given for Back until 10[10,12] rows fewer have been worked than on back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with a ws row.

Shape front neck

Next row (rs) K39[44,50] and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.

Dec one st at neck edge in next 6 rows then on foll 1[1,2] alt rows.32[37,42] sts.

Work one row.

Shape Shoulder

Cast off 5[5,6] sts at beg of next and foll 4[0,1] alt rows then 0[6,7] sts at beg of foll 0[4,3] alt rows and **at same time** dec one st at neck edge in next and foll 4th row.

Work one row then cast off rem 5[6,7] sts.

With rs facing, slip centre 34 sts to a holder, rejoin yarn and K to end.

Complete to match first side of neck, reversing shapings.

SLEEVES

Using 3.25 mm needles cast on 81[87,93] sts and k6 rows.

Change to 4 mm needles and commence pattern.

1st row (rs): K3, * yo, sl, k2tog, pssso, yo, k3, rept from * to end.

2nd row: P to end.

These 2 rows form the patt and are repeated for 6.5cm. Cast off loosely.

NECKBAND

Join right shoulder seam. With rs facing and using 3.25 mm needles, pick up and K15[15,17] sts down left side of front neck, k across 34 sts on front holder, pick up and K15[15,17] sts up right side of front neck and 7 sts down right side of back neck, K across 40[40,42] sts on back neck holder then pick up and K7 sts up left side of back neck. 118[118,124] sts.

Knit 6 rows. Cast off.

MAKING UP

Join left shoulder and neckband seam.

Fold sleeves in half placing centre of sleeve to shoulder seam. Sew sleeves in place down back and fronts.

Join side and sleeve seams.

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
