Jellybaby Chenille Christmas Pud

Measurements

16cm wide x 16cm tall

Materials

Yarn A – 70g Cygnet Jellybaby Chenille Moose (029)

Yarn B – 35g Cygnet Jellybaby Chenille Vanilla Milkshake (031)

Yarn C – 5g Cygnet Jellybaby Chenille Cherry Red (003)

Yarn D – 10g Cygnet Jellybaby Chenille Sprout (025)

Yarn E – Small amount Cygnet 100% cotton Black (2177)

Yarn F – Small amount Cygnet Jellybaby White (001)

100g Stuffing

2 x 16mm Safety Eyes

crochet hook: 4mm

Abbreviations

ch	Chain	dc	Double Crochet	htr	Half Treble Crochet
inv dec	Invisible Double Crochet Decrease	mc	Magic circle	sl st	Slip Stitch
inc	Double Crochet Increase	Picot – ch2, sl st into 2 nd chain from hook			
..	Repeat instructions between asterisks	[...]	Complete instructions into 1 stitch		
st	Stitch				

Place a stitch marker at the start of each row so you don't lose your place.

Body

With 4mm hook and Yarn A make a mc.

Round 1: 6dc into magic circle (6 sts)

Round 2: *inc* x 6 (12 sts)

Round 3: *inc, 1dc* x 6 (18 sts)

Round 4: *inc, 2dc* x 6 (24 sts)

Round 5: *inc, 3dc* x 6 (30 sts)

Round 6: *inc, 4dc* x 6 (36 sts)

Round 7: *inc, 5dc* x 6 (42 sts)

Round 8: *inc, 6dc* x 6 (48 sts)

Round 9: *inc, 7dc* x 6 (54 sts)

Round 10: *inc, 8dc* x 6 (60 sts)

Round 11: *inc, 9dc* x 6 (66 sts)

Round 12: *inc, 10dc* x 6 (72 sts)

Round 13-20: 72dc (72 sts)

Between rows 15 & 16 affix the safety eyes, 9 stitches apart.

Embroider a smile using Yarn E, across row 16, approximately 1 stitch tall and 3 stitches wide, between the safety eyes.

Round 21: *inv dec, 10dc* x 6 (66 sts)

Round 22: *inv dec, 9dc* x 6 (60 sts)

Round 23: *inv dec, 8dc* x 6 (54 sts)

Round 24: *inv dec, 7dc* x 6 (48 sts)

Round 25: *inv dec, 6dc* x 6 (42 sts)

Round 26: *inv dec, 5dc* x 6 (36 sts)

Round 27: *inv dec, 4dc* x 6 (30 sts)

Add stuffing to the body.

Round 28: *inv dec, 3dc* x 6 (24 sts)

Round 29: *inv dec, 2dc* x 6 (18 sts)

Round 30: *inv dec, 1dc* x 6 (12 sts)

Round 31: *inv dec* x 6 (6 sts)

Sl st into the next st and fasten off. Using the tail, sew closed the body.

Icing

With 4mm hook and Yarn B make a mc.

Round 1: 6dc into magic circle (6 sts)

Round 2: *inc* x 6 (12 sts)

Round 3: *inc, 1dc* x 6 (18 sts)

Round 4: *inc, 2dc* x 6 (24 sts)

Round 5: *inc, 3dc* x 6 (30 sts)

Round 6: *inc, 4dc* x 6 (36 sts)

Round 7: *inc, 5dc* x 6 (42 sts)

Round 8: *inc, 6dc* x 6 (48 sts)

Round 9: *inc, 7dc* x 6 (54 sts)

Round 10: *inc, 8dc* x 6 (60 sts)

You'll now make the drip edge to the icing.

Round 11: dc, ch5, dc into second ch from hook, continue 3dc down the ch's, 2dc, ch7, dc into second ch from hook, continue 5dc down the ch's, 3dc, [3htr], 2dc, ch4, dc into second ch from hook, continue 2dc down the ch's, 2dc, [3htr], 3dc,

ch7, dc into second ch from hook, continue 5dc down the ch's, 4dc, ch4, dc into second ch from hook, continue 2dc down the ch's, 3dc, [3htr], 2dc, ch4, dc into second ch from hook, continue 2dc down the ch's, 2dc, ch7, dc into second ch from hook, continue 5dc down the ch's, 4dc, [3htr], 3dc, ch4, dc into second ch from hook, continue 2dc down the ch's, 3dc, [3htr], 2dc, ch7, dc into second ch from hook, continue 5dc down the ch's, 2dc, ch4, dc into second ch from hook, continue 2dc down the ch's, 4dc, [3htr], 3dc, ch4, dc into second ch from hook, continue 2dc down the ch's, 3dc, [3hdc], 3dc, sl st into first stitch from round and fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing the icing to the body. (117 sts)

Berry x 2

With 4mm hook and Yarn C make a mc.

Round 1: 4dc into magic circle, sl st to first stitch in round and fasten off leaving a tail to sew the berry on (4sts)

Holly

With 4mm hook and Yarn D make a ch8.

Round 1: Starting in 2nd chain from hook, 2dc, 3htr, 1dc, in last ch [1dc, ch1, 1dc], you'll now work on the opposite side of the ch, ignore the ch you last stitched into, 1dc, 3htr, 2dc (14 sts)

Round 2: *sl st, [sl st, picot]* x 3, sl st, [sl st, picot] into the ch space from round 1, *sl st, [sl st, picot]* x 3, sl st, fasten off

leaving a tail for assembly. (22 sl sts)

Assembly

Sew the berries and holly to the centre of the icing.

Sew around the drip edge of the icing to the body.

Fasten off and weave in any ends.

Finishing Touches

To finish off the look of your Christmas Pud, you can embroider a white yarn edge to your safety eyes.

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
