Ken's Top and Holdall
DK and 4 PLY

Measurements

To Fit 30 cm Ken Doll

Materials

For Sweater and Bum Bag A small amount of any 4 ply yarn, try our Truly Woolrich 4Ply. 3.25 mm needles

For Holdall A small amount of any DK yarn plus a contrast shade, try our Little Ones DK. 3.25 mm needles

ABBREVIATIONS

G st garter stitch (every row Knit)

Stst stocking stitch (1 row Knit, 1 row Purl)

Top (knit sideways, worked in one piece)

Cast on 24 sts and K12 rows.

Next row cast off 4 sts, K to end. 20 sts

Next row K to end.

Next row Cast off 8 sts, K to end. 12 sts

Next row K to end.

Next row Cast on 8 sts, K to end. 20 sts

Next row K to end.

Next row cast on 4 sts, K to end. 24 sts

K12 rows.

Next row Cast off 12 sts, K to end. 12 sts

Next row K to end.

Next row Cast on 12 sts, K to end. 24 sts

K31 rows.

Next row Cast off 12 sts, K to end. Cast off remaining 12 sts.

Join shoulder seams. Join remaining side seam.

Bum Bag

Cast on 6 sts. Working in g st increase one st at each end of every alternate row to 12 sts.

Next row Cast on 34 sts, then cast off. Sew strap to edge of bag.

Holdall

Using DK yarn cast on 18 sts.

** Working in stst increase one st at each end of every alternate row to 22 sts.

Work 6 rows straight.

Decrease one st at each end of every alternate row to 18 sts.**

Knit 6 rows. (g st)

Repeat from ** to ** once more. Cast off. Fold in half and join side seams.

For Pocket using a contrast shade cast on 10 sts and work 6 rows in stst. Cast off.

Embroider Ken's name on pocket then attach pocket to holdall.

The straps are made by winding the contrast yarn around a length of yarn.

Attach a piece of yarn securely to where the handles are to be placed, a knot can be tied at the back to hold it in place, then just wind yarn around the handle and secure at each end.



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
