



CY1733 CYGNET BABY COLOUR SOFT 3D SHELLS BABY BLANKET

Materials -

- 4.5mm crochet hook
- 2 balls of Cygnet Baby Colour soft DK in Sugar Fairy 551
- 1 ball of Everyday Pato DK in White 999

Pattern notes -

UK terminology used

The starting chain multiple for this blanket is 5 + 4

The blanket shown had a starting chain on 109 and will give you a toddlers sized lap blanket,

The turning chain 1 does not count as a stitch.

The turning chain 3 counts as the 1st treble crochet of the row.

shell – work 3 treble crochet + chain 1 into the ch 2 space + 1 front post treble crochet around the next treble crochet

Abbreviations – sh – shell fo – fasten off yarn

tr – treble crochet ch(s) – chain(s) nxt – next

dc – double crochet sk – skip bet – between

fphtr – front post half treble st(s) - stitch(s) sp(s) - space(s)

crochet tur – turning

htr – half treble crochet t – turn your work

Starting with Baby Colour Soft, make your starting chain

Row 1 – sh into the 6th ch from hook, * sk 4 chs, 3 tr + ch 2 + 1 tr into nxt, rept from * till 3 chs left, sk 2, tr into last

Row 2 – ch 3, t, * sh into ch 2 sp, rept from * across, ending with a tr into the sp between the last st and the tur ch 3

Repeat row 2 until you reach your desired length, fo the Colour Soft and attach the Everyday Pato.

Trim -

Row 1 – attach yarn into any ch sp, ch 1, * dc, ch 2, dc into nxt sp, rept from * all the way around, slst to 1st st Row 2 - slst into the ch 2 sp, ch 1, into each ch 2 sp around, work 1 htr + 2 tr + 1 htr, slst to 1st st

Fasten off and weave in all ends.



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
