





CY1791 YETI CHUNKY GRANNY RECTANGLE CROCHET BLANKET

Materials –

6 mm crochet hook

2 balls each of Cygnet Yeti Chunky100g

Avalanche 2001 - yarn A

Powder Puff 2021 - yarn B

Spritzer 2098 - yarn C

Pattern notes -

UK terminology used

The beginning chain 3 counts as the 1st treble crochet of the row.

The beginning chain 1 does not count as a stitch.

Cluster – 3 treble crochet worked into the same stitch or space.

Corner – 1 cluster + chain 2 + 1 cluster worked into the same stitch or space.

Beginning corner – chain 3 + 2 treble crochet + ch 2 + 3 treble crochet worked into the same stitch or space.

Abbreviations -	ch(s) – chain(s)	nxt – next
tr – treble crochet	sk – skip	bet – between
cl – cluster stitch	st(s) – stitch(s)	sp(s) – space(s)
cor – corner	t – turn your work	slst – slip stitch
bcor – beginning corner	fo – fasten off yarn	

With Yarn A ch 8 and slst to join into a ring, working into ring

Row 1 – ch 3, 2 tr, ch 2, 3 tr, ch 1, 3 tr ch 2, 3 tr, ch 2, 3 tr, ch 1, 3 trx, ch 2, slst to top of ch 3, fo A Row 2 – attach B into nxt ch 2 sp, Work bcor into sp, ch 1, cl into ch 1 sp, ch 1, cor into ch 2 sp, ch 1, cor into ch 2 sp, ch 1, cl into ch 1 sp, ch 1, cor into ch 2 sp, ch 1, slst to top of ch 3, fo B Row 3 – attach C into nxt ch 2 sp, Work bcor into sp, * [ch 1, cl into ch 1 sp] x 2, ch 1, cor into ch 2 sp, ch 1, cl into ch 1 sp, ch 1 *, cor into ch 2 sp, rept from * to * 1 more time, slst to top of ch 3, fo C Row 4 – attach A into nxt ch 2 sp, Work bcor into sp, * [ch 1, cl into ch 1 sp] x 3, ch 1, cor into ch 2 sp, [ch 1, cl into ch 1 sp] x 2, ch 1 *, cor into ch 2 sp, rept from * to * 1 more time, slst to top of ch 3, fo C You should now be able to see the pattern forming with 4 corners, 3 clusters on the long sides and 2 clusters on the shorter side.

Continue working as follows, changing colours after every row

- Attach your yarn into any corner ch 2 sp and work the bcor
- Ch 1 and work a cl into the ch 1 sp, ch, rept to you reach the corner
- Ch 1 and work a cor into the ch 2 sp
- Rept all the way round, making sure every cl is separated by a ch 1,
- finish by slip stitching into the top of ch 3, fo yarn

Continue until you run out of yarn, weave in all ends.
