## CyGNET LITTLE ONES A-Z DK

## Materials -

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    4 mm crochet hook. Wooden Hoop. Stuffing. Invisible Hanging Thread
    1 x 25g ball each of Cygnet Little Ones A - Z DK (2 of apple)
    Yarn A - Quiet Purple 984
    Yarn B - Future Royal }99
    Yarn C - Tropic }99
    Yarn D - Intense Green 973
    Yarn E - Orange 995
    Yarn F - Yellow }99
    Yarn G - Red 994
    Yarn H - White }99
```


## Pattern Notes -

UK terminology used
The number in Brackets (), is the amount of stitches or pattern repeats you should have at the end of that row/round.
The chain 1 does not count as a stitch, always work into the 1st stitch of the row unless otherwise stated.
Increase - 2 double crochet worked into the same stitch.
Decrease - double crochet together worked over 2 stitches.

| Abbreviations - | dbltr - double treble crochet | nxt - next |
| :--- | :--- | :--- |
| dc - double crochet | inc - increase | rept - repeat |
| htr - half treble crochet | dec - decrease | sk - skip |
| tr - treble crochet | ch(s) - chain(s) | slst - slip stitch |

## Rainbow - make 2

With yarn A ch 9
Row 1 - starting in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook, inc into $1^{\text {st }}$, dc $6,4 \times \mathrm{dc}$ into last, working on the opposite side, dc 6 , inc into last, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st

Row 2 - ch 1 , inc into each st around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st, fo $A$
Row 3 - with B, ch 1 , dc into each st around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st, fo B
Row 4 - with C, ch 1, dc into each st around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st, fo C
Row 5 - with D, *dc 1, inc into nxt, rept from * around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st, fo D
Row 6 - with E, ch 1, dc into each st around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st, fo $E$
Row 7 - with F, ch 1, dc into each st around, sist to $1^{\text {st }}$ st, fo $F$
Row 8 - with G, *dc 3, inc into nxt, rept from * around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 9 - ch 1, dc into each st around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.
Fold edges with right side facing outwards, and using matching yarn, whip stitch both sides together, stuffing as you go.

## Sun - make 1

With yarn F make a magic ring
Row 1 -ch 1,6 dc into ring, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 2 - ch 1, inc into each st around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 3 - ch 1, *dc 1, inc into nxt, rept from * around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 4 - ch 1, dc 1, inc into nxt, *dc 2, inc into nxt, rept from * 4 more times, dc 1 , slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 5 - ch 1, * dc 3, inc into nxt, rept from * around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 6 - ch 1, dc 2, inc into nxt, * dc 4, inc into nxt, rept from * 4 more times, dc 2 , slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 7 - ch 1, dc into each st around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Make an identical piece, do not fasten off.

Hold the 2 pieces together with the right sides facing out and dc all the way around, stuffing as you go.
Row 8 - ch 1, * dc 5, inc into nxt, rept from * 5 more times, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st, fo F
Spikes - with yarn Ejoin yarn in any stitch, ch 1 , * into $1^{\text {st }}$ st work dc + htr, into $2^{\text {nd }}$ st work $t r+d b l t r+c h 1+$ dbltr + tr, into $3^{\text {rd }}$ st work htr + dc, rept from * all the way around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st, fo E
(14 spikes)

## Cloud - make 1

With yarn H make a magic ring
Row 1 - ch 1 , dc 6 , slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 2 - ch 1, inc into each st around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 3 - ch 1, *dc 1, inc into nxt, rept from * around slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 4 - * 2 dc, inc into nxt, rept from * around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Rows 5 to 8 - ch 1, dc around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 9 - ch 1, dc 4, inc 6 times, 14 dc, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 10 -ch 1, dc around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 11 - ch 1, dc 10, inc 4 times, dc 16 , slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Rows 12 to 19 - ch 1 , dc around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 20 - ch 1, dc 12, dec 4 times, dc 14 , slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 21 - ch 1, dc around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 22 - ch 1 , dc 8 , dec 6 times, dc 10 , slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 23 - ch 1, dc 9, dec 2 times, dc 11, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 24 - ch 1, dc 7, inc 6 times, dc 9 , slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Rows 25 to 31 - ch 1 , sc around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 32 - ch 1, dc 9 , dec 6 times, dc 7, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 33 - ch 1, dc 7, dec 4 times, dc 7, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Rows 34 and $35-$ ch 1 , dc around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 36 - ch 1, dc 1, dec, rept around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 37 - ch 1, dc around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st, fo leaving enough tail to close the gap. Stuff and close seam

## Raindrops - make 3 each in yarn B and C

With selected yarn make a magic ring
Row 1 - ch 1 , into ring work 6 dc , slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 2 - ch 1, dc around slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 3 - ch 1, *inc, dc 2, rept from * around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 4 - ch 1, *inc, dc 3, rept from * around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 5 - ch 1, *inc, dc 4, rept from * around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st

Rows 9 to 11 - ch 1 , dc around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 12 - ch 1, * dec, dc 1, rept from * around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 13 - ch 1, dec around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st, fo leaving enough tail to close the gap. Stuff and close seam (6)

## Lightning bolt - make 2

Row 1 - ch 8, dc into $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook, dc across. Turn

Rows 2 to 5 - ch 1, t, dc across
Row 6 - ch 5, t, dc into $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch, dc into nxt 3 chs, dc 7
Rows 7 to 9 - ch 1, dc across. Turn
Rows 10 to 13 - ch 1, t, dc 7
Row 14 - ch $5, \mathrm{t}$, dc into $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch, dc into nxt 3 chs, dc 3
Rows 15 and 16 - ch 1, t, dc 7
Row 17 - ch 1, t, slst into nxt 4 sts, dc 3
Row 18 - ch 1, t, dc 3
Row 19 - ch 1, t, dec, dc 1
Row 20 - ch 1, t, dc 1, fo leaving a long tail for sewing together
Make an identical piece, do not fasten off.
Hold the 2 pieces together and whip stitch the two sides together all the way around, stuffing as you go.

## Covering hoop -

With 2 strands of D held together, join to hoop, ch 1, and dc around hoop until no more wood is visible, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st, fo D

## Hanging strands - make 4

With 2 strands of D held together, ch 30 , fasten off leaving a long tail for attaching.
Sew your 4 ties onto the wooden frame at 12, 3, 6 and 9 o'clock, tie your other ends onto the hoop.
Weave in all ends back down through the chain.
Using your invisible thread, attach your shapes onto your frame, making sure to double knot all ends and weave them in.


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
