

## **CY 1 198 Seriously Chunky Metallics The Antler Cable Hat**

## Measurements Size One size Circumference (in) 19.75 (cm) 50 Length (excludes pompom) 99 (in) (cm) 22 **Materials** 3 **Cygnet Seriously Chunky** 100g **Metallics - Lithium 811**

Needles	Notions	Tension
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8mm circular knitting needles Yarn needle 9 sts/10 rows = 10cm/4in square
Stitch markers on 8mm needles in Stocking Stitch

## **KEY**

St/Sts Stitch/Stitches K Knit P Purl SI Slip

**Bobble** work 3 K sts in one st, turn work, then P3, turn work, then K2tog, K1, and pass 1<sup>st</sup> st over 2<sup>nd</sup> st, then continue working

Antler Cable SI1 to cable needle and hold at back of work, K2, K1 from cable needle, then SI2 to cable needle and hold at front of work, K1, K2 from cable needle

Antler Cable Derease SI1 to cable needle and hold at back of work, K2tog, K1 from cable needle, then SI2 to cable needle and hold at front of work, K1, SSK from cable needle

K3tog Knit 3 stitches together

Row.1 Cast on 54 sts using the long tail cast-on technique.

Join your sts in the round, taking care not to twist the cast on edge.

**Row.2** Work in 1x1 rib for 10 rows.

Row.3 \*P1, K1, P1, K6; repeat from \* to the end of the round

Row.4 Repeat Step 3

Row.5 \*P1, Bobble, P1, Antler Cable; repeat from \* to the end of the round

Row.6 Repeat Step 3, three times

**Row.7** \*P1, K1, P1, Antler Cable; repeat from \* to the end of the round

Row.8 Repeat Step 3, three times

**Row.9** Repeat Step 5-6, one more time

Row.10 \*P1, Bobble, P1, SI1, K2tog, Antler Cable decrease; repeat from \* to the end of the round **Row.11** \*P1, K1, P1, K4; repeat from \* to the end of the round

Row.12 \*P1, K1, P1, K2tog, SSK; repeat from \* to the end of the round

**Row.13** \*P1, K1, P1, K2; repeat from \* to the end of the round

**Row.14** \*K3tog, K2; repeat from \* to the end of the round

Row.15 Cut yarn, leaving a 20cm yarn tail. Thread yarn tail onto a sewing needle, then thread through every remaining st. Remove circular needles, and pull yarn tightly to close top of hat. Thread yarn through top sts again, then weave in ends on the inside of the hat.

**Row.16** Make a pompom, and sew securely to the top of the hat.
