YETI
Furry Cowl

This pattern is perfect for beginners and people using Faux fur yarn for the first time.
Skill Level: Beginner.
This pattern is written using U.S. terminology.

## MEASUREMENTS

Finished Size: 2in long and 10in wide.

## MATERIALS

10 mm crochet hook
$2 \times 100 \mathrm{~g}$ balls of Cygnet Yarns Yeti shade Rockies 2087

## ABBREVIATIONS

CH - Chain
ST - Stitch
SL ST - Slip Stitch
SC - Single Crochet
F/O- Finish off

## TENSION

Gauge isn't important as long as the same tension is maintained throughout.
Adjusting the size of your cowl. The Width:- To make the cowl wider (taller when worn), add more chains to your starting chain. Or use less chains to make it narrower (shorter when worn). The Length:- To make the length of the cowl longer add more rows until you are happy with it.

## TIPS

With faux fur yarn it is difficult to see your stitches so I recommend:

- Count each stitch as you work.

Feel your stitches and you will know where to place your hook.

## PATTERN

We are going to be working with two balls of yarn at the same time, so by holding two strands together, CH 21. 1: SC in the 2nd CH from the hook and in each ST across. CH 1 and turn. (20) $2-52$ : SC in each ST across. CH 1 and turn. (20) After working to 52 rows, you should have what looks like a large furry rectangle! This is a good point to wrap it around yourself to see if you would like to add length, make it shorter or to see if it's just right! F/O leaving a long tail to sew the two ends together. Weave in the ends and pop it on! Oh so cosy!

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
