

CY1706 Cygnet Pure Baby DK Fairytale Cushion

Measurements

To fit 18 x 18 (45 x 45cm) inch cushion

Materials

Pure Baby DK Petal Pink 2124	100g	1
Pure Baby DK Sherbert 2278	100g	1
Pure Baby DK Lilac 2113	100g	1
Pure Baby DK White 2080	100g	1
Pure Baby DK Dapple 2986	100g	1
Pure Baby DK Pastel Blue 2242	100g	1
Pure Baby DK 2021 Peppermint	100g	1

Needles	Other	Tension
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1 pair of 4mm (UK 8/US 6) 3 large buttons 22 sts over 28 rows to 4 inch (10cm) 45 x 45cm cushion pad square over stst using 4mm needles

IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE THE CORRECT SIZING. If your tension square has less stitches, use a thinner needle, if more, use a thicker needle.

Abbreviations

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Tips on Intarsia

When changing colour, twist the first colour and the back colour at the back of the work before working the stitch to ensure there isn't a hole in the work.

Don't carry a colour across the back of the work for more than 4 or 5 stitches as this can affect the tension. Instead, wind a bobbin of each colour you are using for each section to keep the work neat at the back.

Work from the bottom of the chart, working each knit row from right to left and each purl row from left to right. Mark off rows that you have worked on to keep track of where you are up to.

FRONT

With 4mm needles and Peppermint cast on 90 sts (this is the first line of the chart).

Work straight in stst from bottom of chart to top, working knit rows from right to left and purl rows from left to right.

When chart is complete, cast off.

BACK (Bottom)

With 4mm needles and Lilac, cast on 90 sts. Work 56 rows in stst.**

Change to **Pastel Blue** and work as follows:

Row 1: (k2, p2) to end **Row 2:** (p2, k2) to end

Last two rows form patt.

Repeat last 2 rows 10 more times (22 rows in total) and cast off in 2x2 rib.

BACK (top)

Work as for Back bottom to **. Change to **Pastel Blue** and work Rib pattern as set above for 4 rows. **Buttonhole row:** patt across 22 sts, cast off next 2 sts, patt across 20 sts (including 1 already on right hand needle from cast off), cast off next 2 sts, patt across 20 sts (including 1 already on right hand needle from cast off 2 sts), patt to end

Next row: patt across row, casting on 2 sts where sts were cast off on previous row.

Work 6 more rows in patt. Cast off in 2 x 2 rib.


Making Up

Weave in loose ends.

Place back bottom over bottom half of front, with wrong sides together with ribbed section pointing up, seam in place.

Place back top over top half of front, overlapping the Back bottom on the ribbed section. Seam in place. Attach buttons. Embroider flags in Dapple, the lvy in Peppermint and the door





knobs in Sherbert.

Some of the chart shades differ from actual shades used. Refer to photo image for actual guidance



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
