CYNET BOHO SPIRIT HALLOWEEN EAR WARMERS

Materials

4 mm crochet hook

1 ball per size of Cygnet Boho Spirit in shade Wicked 6875 or Vamp 6999

Pattern Notes

UK terminology used

The turning chain 3 counts as a treble crochet

Shell – work a 2 treble crochet + chain 1 + 1 treble crochet all into the same stitch or space

Abbreviations

tr – Treble crochet
sh – shell stitch

ch(s) - chain(s)
t - turn your work
nxt – next
rept - repeat

sk - skip
sp(s) - space(s)
slst – slip stitch
fo – fasten off

INSTRUCTIONS

To begin make your desired chain size

Toddler – chain 19

Teen – chain 22

Adult – chain 25

Row 1 – work a sh into 4th ch from hook, * sk 2 chs, sh into nxt, rept from * till 3 sts left, sk 2, tr into last

Row 2 – ch 3, t, * sh into nxt ch 1 sp, sk 3 tr, rept from * across ending with a tr into the top of the ch 3

Rept row 2 for the following row counts below, or until you have a comfortable fit around your head.

Toddler 36 rows **Teen** 38 rows **Adult** 40 rows

Finishing

1. Lay the ear warmer on a flat surface with the right side facing up
2. Fold in half as shown in step 2
3. Pinch both ends and lock them in together as shown in step 3
4. Using your darning needle, sew the edges together, making sure to go through all 4 layers
5. Turn out the correct way and place a few stitches to hold your twist in place and stop the edges curling up
