



**CY1840 Boho Spirit
Festive Wrap**

Finished Measurements

150 x 75 cm (59 x 30 ins)

Materials

Cygnet Boho Spirit 100g
Oh What Fun 6228

4

Hooks

5mm hook

Tension

Tension is not important for this project. Just make sure that it is not so loose that the garment loses its definition.

Abbreviations

ch chain

ch3sp 3 chain space

chsp chain space

dc double crochet (UK term)

dc2tog insert hook into next st, yo, draw loop through st (2 loops on hook), sk3, insert hook into next st, yo, draw up loop through st (3 loops on hook), yo, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

sk skip

slst slip stitch

tr treble crochet (UK term)

Note: Increases are made in the two edge stitches and in the centre spine of the shawl.

PATTERN

With 5mm hook

Ch 5 and join with a slst in the first ch to form a ring.

Row 1: Ch 3 (counts as first tr) 4 tr, ch 3, 5 tr, in the ring

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first tr), tr in same st, 1 tr in the next 4 stitches, (2 tr, ch 3, 2 tr) in ch 3 space, 1 tr in the next 4 stitches, 2 tr in the top of the ch 3 from the previous round

Row 3: as Row 2, working 2 tr in first and last st and (2tr, ch3, 2tr) in centre chsp.

Row 4: Ch 4 (counts as first tr plus 1 ch), (1 tr, ch 1, 1 tr, ch 1) in same

stitch, *Sk next stitch, (tr, ch 1) in next stitch**. Repeat between * and ** to centre ch3sp. Work 1 tr, ch1, 1 tr, ch 3, 1 tr, ch 1, 1 tr, ch1 in ch3sp.

*Work 1 tr, ch 1, sk1** Repeat between * and ** to last st, work 1 tr, ch 1, 1 tr in top of ch3 from last row.

Row 5: Ch 3 (counts as first tr), tr in same st, 1 tr in each stitch and ch 1 space to centre ch3sp. Work (2 tr, ch 3, 2 tr) in ch3sp. Work 1 tr in each stitch and ch 1 space to last stitch, work 1 tr in chsp, 2 tr in top of ch3.

Repeat Rows 4 and 5 until the shawl measures 150cm (59 inches) across top, ending on a Row 4.

BORDER

Next row: ch1, dc in same st, *ch5, sk2 ch sp, dc in next chsp; rep from * to centre ch3sp, (dc, ch5, dc) in ch3sp, *ch5, sk2 ch sp, dc in next chsp; rep from * to last st, 2dc in last st.

Next row: ch1, *dc 7 in ch5sp, dc in next st; rep from *to end, also working dc 7 in centre point.

Next row: ch 1, dc in same st, ch5, *dc in centre st of dc 7 of previous row, ch8; rep from * to last dc 7

before centre, ch5, dc in dc before centre, ch 8, dc in dc after centre, ch 5, *dc in centre of dc7 from previous row, ch8; rep from * to last dc 7, dc in centre of dc 7, ch 5, dc 2 in last st.

Next row: (dc 2, ch 3, dc 2) in ch5sp, dc in centre of dc 7 from 2 rows below, *(dc 4, ch3, dc 4) in ch8sp, dc in centre of dc 7 from 2

rows below; repeat in each ch 8 sp to corner, (dc 2, ch 3, dc 2) in ch5sp, dc in dc from 2 rows below, (dc 4, ch 3, dc 4) in centre ch8sp, dc in dc from 2 rows below, dc 2, ch 3, dc 2) in ch5sp, * dc in centre of dc 7 from 2 rows below, (dc 4, ch3, dc 4) in ch8sp; rep from * to last ch5 sp, (dc 2, ch 3, dc 2) in ch5 sp, slst in last st and fasten off

Making up

Sew in any loose ends.

(Optional) Make two 6cm diameter pompoms and attach to the two outer corners of the scarf.
