

# CY1281 WATERCOLOUR DK CHILDS V STITCH PONCHO IN 3 SIZES

## **Materials**

Watercolour DK 100g (I ball for small, 2 balls for medium and large)

Shades featured Crimson Forest 3860 & Rainbow Lake 3750

5 mm Crochet Hook

Darning Needle

Pattern Notes

US Terminology used

The numbers at the end of each row in brackets, are the amount of stitches or pattern repeats you should have at the end of that row.

The chain 1 does not count as a stitch. Always work the 1st stitch straight back down into the base of the chain 1 unless otherwise stated.

You will increase by 1 v stitch on each side of every row

Small - age 3 - 4 Medium - age 5 - 6 Large - age 7 - 8

## Small -

Ch 72 / slst to form a ring, being careful not to twist

```
1 – Ch 1 / hdc in each st around / slst to 1st hdc (72)
```

2 - Ch 1 / cor into 1st st / \* sk 2 / v-st into nxt\* / rep from \* to \* 10 more times / sk 2 / cor into nxt / rept from \* to \* 11 times / slst to 1st dc (cor + 11 vsts + cor + 11 vsts)

3 – Slst into the ch2 sp of the cor / ch1 / work a cor / \*work a v-st into every sp bet the v-sts of the previous row, until you reach the nxt cor\* / cor into ch2 sp / work from \* to \* till the end of the row / slst into the 1st dc made

(cor + 12 vsts + cor + 12 vsts)

Continue to repeat row 3 with the following increases, until you have reached your desired length

4 - cor / 13 vsts / cor / 13 vsts

5 - cor / 14 vsts / cor / 14 vsts

6 - cor / 15 vsts / cor / 15 vsts

7 - cor / 16 vsts / cor / 16 vsts

8 - cor / 17 vsts / cor / 17 vsts

9 - cor / 18 vsts / cor / 18 vsts

10-cor / 19 vsts / cor / 19 vsts

#### Medium -

Ch 78 / slst to form a ring, being careful not to twist

1 – ch 1 / hdc into each st around / slst to 1st hdc (78)

2 - Ch 1 / cor into 1st st / \* sk 2 / v-st into nxt\* / rep from \* to \* 11 more times / sk 2 / cor into nxt / rept from \* to \* 12 more times / slst to 1st dc (cor + 12 vsts + cor + 12 vsts)

3 – Slst into the ch2 sp of the cor / ch1 / work a cor / \*work a v-st into every sp bet the v-sts of the previous row, until you reach the nxt cor\* / cor into ch2 sp / work from \* to \* till the end of the row / slst into the 1st dc made

(cor + 13 vsts + cor + 13 vsts)

Continue to repeat row 3 with the following increases, until you have reached your desired length

4 - cor / 14 vsts / cor / 14 vsts

5 - cor / 15 vsts / cor / 15 vsts

6 - cor / 16 vsts / cor / 16 vsts

7 - cor / 17 vsts / cor / 17 vsts

8 - cor / 18 vsts / cor / 18 vsts

9 - cor / 19 vsts / cor / 19 vsts

10 - cor / 20 vsts / cor / 20 vsts

And so on.

### Large -

Ch 84 / slst to form a ring, being careful not to twist

1 – ch 1 / hdc in each st around / slst to 1st hdc (84)

2 - Ch 1 / cor into 1st st / \* sk 2 / v-st into nxt\* / rep from \* to \* 12 more times / sk 2 / cor into nxt / rept from \* to \* 12 times / slst to 1st dc (cor + 13 vsts + cor + 13 vsts)

3 – Slst into the ch2 sp of the cor / ch1 / work a cor / \*work a v-st into every sp bet the v-sts of the previous row, until you reach the nxt cor\* / cor into ch2 sp / work from \* to \* till the end of the row / slst into the 1st dc made (cor + 14 vsts + cor + 14 vsts)

Continue to repeat row 3 with the following increases, until you have reached your desired length

4 - cor / 15 vsts / cor / 15 vsts

5 - cor / 16 vsts / cor / 16 vsts

6 - cor / 17 vsts / cor / 17 vsts

7 - cor / 18 vsts / cor / 18 vsts

8 – cor / 19 vsts / cor / 19 vsts

9 - cor / 20 vsts / cor / 20 vsts

10 - cor / 21 vsts / cor / 21 vsts

## Tassels - Make 4

- · Cut a piece of cardboard to which ever height you prefer
- Cut 8 6-inch lengths of yarn

- Wrap your yarn around the cardboard 20 times
- Slip one piece of yarn though the centre and tie tightly at the top
- Slide the Tassel off the cardboard and lay flat on top of a piece of yarn that is laying horizontal
- Tie tightly around about 2 cm from the top
- Use a darning needle to feed these lengths though the centre to blend them in
- Use the 2 lengths to attach to the poncho corners
- Use a darning needle to feed these lengths though the centre on the tassel to blend them in
- Trim Neatly
