

# Petal Patchwork Blanket Cal



## ***Measurements***

Size: approx. 81cm x 81cm (32"x 32")

## ***Materials***

Yarn – Cygnet Yarns 100% Cotton

Yarn A – 100g Dandelion (6449)

Yarn B – 300g White (2080)

Yarn C – 100g Lemongrass (6827)

Yarn D – 100g Peony Pink (4065)

Yarn E – 100g Peach Sorbet (6724)

Yarn F – 100g Spring (6711)

Hook – 4mm

Scissors

Tapestry/Wool Needle



## ***Notes***

- Patterns written in UK Terms.
- Ch1 at the beginning of each round DOES NOT count as a stitch.
- There are 3 different flower squares to make in the cal.
- Join as you go method for joining your squares.
- Each square is worked in the round.
- The CAL will be over 5 weeks.
- Week 1 squares will be bigger than your other squares, but this is ok as the joining and border help with this.



- If you decide to make the blanket in a different yarn to cotton, then you may want to turn before the Bobbles rounds of the flower and work them on the wrong side, so they sit nice and bobbly.

## ***Abbreviations***

CH – Chain

SS – Slip stitch

MR – Magic Ring

DC – Double crochet

HTR – Half treble crochet

TR – Treble crochet

Bo – Bobble stitch

V-st – V-Stitch

[ ] – Repeat as many times stated

( ) – In the same stitch

STS – Number of stitches

YO – Yarn Over



## ***Special Stitches***

Bobble - \*Yo, insert hook, yo, pull through, yo, pull through 2; repeat from \* 4 more times, you should have 6 loops on the hook, yo, pull through all 6 loops.

V-Stitch – (1tr, ch1, 1tr) in same stitch.

## ***Tension***

22 stitches x 10 rows (4-inch square) with the double crochet stitch
