

CY1812 CHEVRON THROW OVER COTTON DROPS

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 70 x 100 cm (28 x 40 in)

MATERIALS

Cygnet Cotton Drops 4 x 100g balls of 4 shades: (A) Light Ocean 5444

(B) Lavender Haze 5888

(C) Sweet Pink 5555

(D) Thunder Grey 5333

Circular knitting needle size 15 (10 mm) at least 73 cm long

TENSION IS NOT IMPORTANT FOR THIS PROJECT

ABBREVIATIONS

Beg beginning

K knit

Kfb K into front and back of next st (1 st increased)

K2tog knit 2 stitches together

Rep repeat

St(s) stitch(es)

NOTES

The Chevron pattern is worked back and forth in rows of a simple ripple pattern, kfb peaks and k2tog valleys. Take care to keep the peaks and valleys aligned.

Yarn colour is changed to form stripe sequence.

The circular needle is used to accommodate all the stitches but rows are worked, not rounds.

STRIPE SEQUENCE

Work 12 rows in pattern with A, 12 rows with B, 12 rows in C, 12 rows in D then 16 rows in A, 16 rows in B, 16 rows in C and 16 rows in D, totalling 112 rows.

INSTRUCTIONS

Using A, cast on 156 sts. Note: cast on counts as 1st row worked using A.

Row 1: * K5, k2tog, k4, kfb, rep from * to end. 13 ripples

Using A, rep row 1 for 10 more rows. Break off A, join in B.

Rep row 1 for 12 rows. Break off B, join in C.

Rep row 1 and continue to change colour following stripe sequence as above for 112 rows. Additional length can be made if desired before casting off.

Weave in ends.

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
