WOOLLY ARAN**

**MEASUREMENTS**

	S	M	L	XL	
To Fit Bust ( <b>Actual Measurement</b> )	93	103	113	122	cm
	36 ½	40	44 ½	48	in

**MATERIALS**

Cygnet Woolly Aran 400g Rosehill Cottage 4100 4 4 5 5 balls

A pair of 4.5 and 5 mm (US 7 and 8) Knitting needles

Stitch holders. Stitch markers.

**TENSION**

20 sts and 28 rows to 10 cm (4 in) measured over pattern using 5 mm needles

If your tension is too tight use a larger needle, if too loose use a smaller needle

**ABBREVIATIONS**

**FRONT**

Using the smaller needles cast on 95[103,115,123] sts and work 6 cm in K1, P1 rib. Place a stitch marker at end of last row worked.

**Change to larger needle and commence pattern**

**Row 1(rs):** K3, \* P1, K3, rept from \* to end.

**Row 2:** K1, \* P1, K3, rept from \* to last 2 sts, P1, K1.

**Rows 3 – 6:** Rept rows 1 and 2 twice.

**Row 7:** K1, \* P1, K3, rept from \* to last 2 sts, P1, K1.

**Row 8:** K3, \* P1, K3, rept from \* to end.

**Rows 9 – 12:** Rept rows 7 and 8 twice.

These 12 rows form the pattern and are repeated. Cont in patt (throughout) until Front measures

49[51,54,57] cm, ending with a ws row.

**Shape Neck**

**Next row (rs):** Patt 40[43,49,52] sts and turn leaving rem 55[60,66,71] sts on hold.

**Next row:** cast off 6 sts, patt to end. 34[37,43,46] sts.

**Next row:** Patt to end. Work 7 rows in patt, dec one st at neck edge in every row. 27[30,36,39] sts.

Work 4[4,6,6] rows straight. Place a stitch marker at end of last row worked.

**Shape Shoulder**

Cast off 9[10,12,13] sts at beg of next and foll rs row. Work one row and cast off rem 9[10,12,13] sts.

With rs facing, slip next 15[17,17,19] sts to a holder,

rejoin yarn to rem 40[43,49,52] sts and patt to end.

**Next row:** Patt to end. Complete to match first side, reversing neck and shoulder shapings.

**Note..... the hem on this garment is 6cm longer at the Back than the Front therefore the Back will be 6 cm longer than Front.**

**BACK**

Using the smaller needles cast on 95[103,115,123] sts and **work 12 cm** in K1, P1 rib.

Place a stitch marker at end of last row worked.

**Change to larger needle** and work in pattern as given for Front until Back

measures same as Front from marker at top of rib to marker at side edge to shoulder ending with a ws row.

### **Shape Shoulders and Back Neck**

**Next row (rs):** Cast off 9[10,12,13] sts, work 19[21,25,27] sts (including last st used for casting off) and turn, leaving rem 67[72,78,83] sts on hold.

**Next row:** P1, P2tog, patt to end.

**Next row:** Cast off 9[10,12,13] sts, patt to end. Work one row and cast off rem 9[10,12,13] sts.

With rs facing, slip next 39[41,41,43] sts onto a

holder, rejoin yarn to rem sts and patt to end.

**Next row:** cast off 9[10,12,13] sts, patt to last 3 sts, P2togtbl, P1.

**Next row:** Patt to end.

**Next row:** cast off 9[10,12,13] sts, patt to end. Cast off rem sts.

### **COLLAR**

Join right shoulder seam. With rs facing and using smaller needle, pick up and K17 sts down side of front neck, pick up and K5 sts from cast off sts at front neck, K across 15[17,17,19]sts from centre front holder, pick up and K5 sts across cast off sts at front neck, K17 sts up side of front

neck, pick up and K3 sts down side of back neck, K across 39[41,41,43] sts from centre back holder and pick up and K4 sts up side of back neck. 105[111,111,115] sts. Work 8 cm in K1, P1 rib. Change to larger needle and work a further 8 cm in rib. Cast off loosely in rib.

### **FINISHING OFF**

Join left shoulder seam. Join collar seam reversing seam halfway for turnback. Place markers 24[26,28,29] cm down from shoulder seams on front and back side edges. Join side seams from top of rib to markers, leaving rib section open. Sew in all ends.
